The band currently has seven members: Alejandra Quiroz (lead singer, keys), Casey Dezsi (lead singer, keys), Joe Gajda (bass, vocals, keys, trumpet), Kayla Henneman (guitar, bass, and vocals), Hayden Allie (lead guitarist), Brenden Post (keys, vocals) and Beth Pearson (drums and percussion).

The Stale Crackers have played professional and charity gigs throughout the downriver area over the last 5

years. Wyandotte 3rd Fridays, Kidapalooza, Trenton Street Fair, Melvindale Street Fair, Woodhaven Uncle Sam Fun Fest, Allen Park Street Fair, Trenton Scarecrow Fest, and A & R Rock Band shows are just some of the shows that The Stale Crackers have played. Rates paid to the band have ranged from \$150 - \$300 per hour with and/or without back lines.

The Stale Crackers can currently play about 70 Classic and Current Rock, Alternative and Pop songs. They can also learn requested songs, usually for private parties, if given an advanced notice. Some of the band's current songs include Super Massive Black Hole by Muse, We Got the Beat by the Go Go's, and Hound Dog by Elvis Presley. Their music can be directed towards kids, teenagers, college students, parents or grandparents depending on the event. The band is very good at playing an even mix that everyone can enjoy at family events.
